



PARENTAL CONTROLS FOR APPLE MAC.




1. You start by clicking on 'System Preferences' and in the 'System' category click on 'Parental Controls' once you have clicked on this the screen below will pop up.

2. On this step, you have to fill in your required details that, (it is optional to leave a password hint). Once you have filled in your detail click 'Create Account'.




3. After you have created your account, the screen will change to this, this is where you can change or adapt your parental options, (the image shows the screen as it will be once you have pressed continue).

4. You can change the parental controls for the internet in this window by selecting 'Web' on the tabs at the top. By doing this you can select specific sites and monitor your child's Internet use.




5. Clicking on the 'People' tab allows you to control what you wish your child access and filter the people they contact during game play etc.

6. You can also set a time limit.

To create a specific time just set it up in this section by entering the number of hours you want the computer to be accessible.

The recommended safe time for using VDU (visual display units) equipment is 2 hours.



7. Finally, you can set limits for other applications for example; limiting down printing usage; CD and DVD Burning usage.

You can disable 'changing the password' in this window.
