

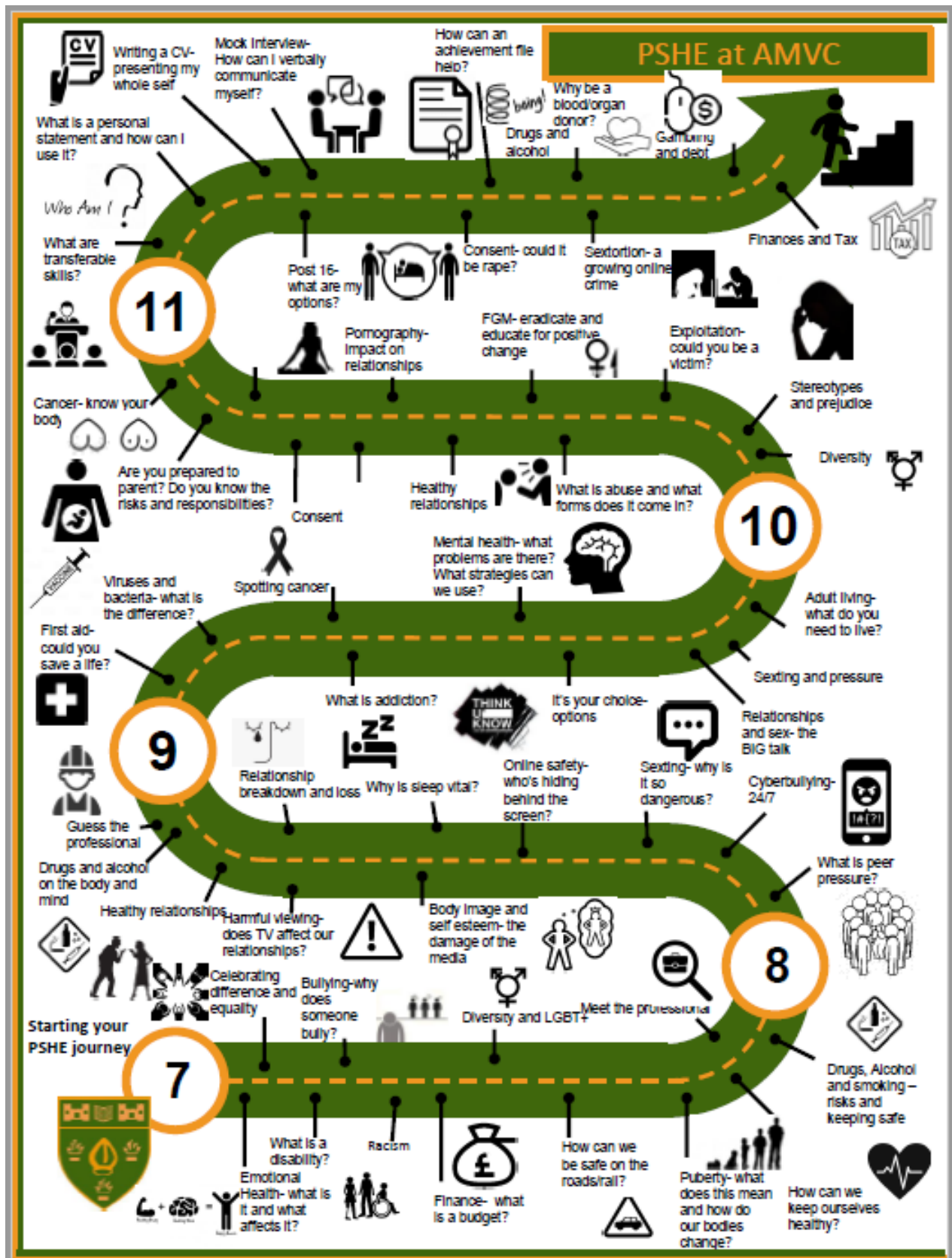
Careers Framework
