Year 12

- The key focus of Year 12 Fine Art is enabling students to build high levels of technical skill, critical understanding and creativity in preparation for their large coursework projects and examinations in Year 13.
- Year 12 Mock Exam takes place towards the end of Year 12 with the question paper released in March.
- The exam includes several weeks of preparation time and a 10 hour sustained focus
- From September to January students will focus on developing their practical and critical skills through teacher lead assignments. Students will focus on the course principles of the Fine Art specification.

Year 13

- 60% coursework
- 40% examination
- Examination takes place in April
- The exam includes approximately 8 weeks of preparation and a 15 hour sustained focus.
