Year 1

- Paper 1: Philosophy of Religion (Philosophical issues and questions; The nature & influence of religious experience; Problems of evil & suffering)
- Paper 2: Religion & Ethics (Significant concepts in issues or debates in religion and ethics; A study of three ethical theories; Application of ethical theories to issues of importance
- Paper 3: Study of Hinduism (Religious beliefs, values and teachings; Sources of wisdom and authority; Practices that shape and express religious identity)

Year 2

No coursework: 100% examination in June

Three examinations:

- Paper 1: Philosophy of Religion (Philosophical language; Works of scholars; Influences of developments in religious belief)
- Paper 2: Religion & Ethics (Ethical language; Deontology, Virtue Ethics and the works
 of scholars; Medical ethics: beginning & end of life Issues)
- Paper 3: study of Hinduism (Social and historical developments; Works of scholars; Religion and society)
