ACTIVITY DAYS INFORMATION - CYCLING

In the Autumn term your child chose a trip for our Activity Days from Wednesday 17 to Friday 19 July 2024. This is to confirm that your child has been allocated a place on the above trip for the three days.

Your child will need to have their own bike which must be roadworthy and have decent brakes. We will be cycling on and off road. We will not accept students onto the trip if they are not wearing cycle helmets or intend to ride a BMX. Students with BMX bikes have struggled to keep up in previous years.

Each day we have a different route including cycling to Ferry Meadows and Crowland. It is assumed that students are sensible when cycling on roads.

A packed lunch will be required each day. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, they can collect a packed lunch from the College Refectory before we depart for the day. We pass a shop on each route so enough money for an ice cream would be nice.
