ACTIVITY DAYS - ADRENALINE JUNKIE

ITINERARY

Wednesday 17 July 2024 – Letchworth Go Karting

With exclusive use of the whole indoor track, students have 3 hours of roll-on roll-off racing. No open toed shoes allowed. Balaclavas, gloves and a race suits are provided.

Thursday 18 July 2024 – Salcey Forest – GoApe

2 hours of Treetop Adventures. Kit List: Sportswear (leggings, tracksuit bottoms, shorts, trainers) – make sure it is appropriate and comfortable. Gloves are also recommended for comfort. No opened toed shoes. NO crop tops – the harness will rub otherwise. Long hair must also be tied back.
