Course Outline

The Extended Certificate is the equivalent of one A Level and is made up of 4 units which include the 'mandatory' units 1 - 3 plus one other 'optional unit'. Two units are studied in Year 12 and two in Year 13.

The Foundation Diploma is the equivalent of 1.5 A Levels and is made up of 6 units which include the 'mandatory' Units 1 - 4 plus 2 other 'optional units'. 3 units are studied in Year 12 and 3 in Year 13.

The **Diploma** is the equivalent of 2 A Levels and is made up of 8 units which include the 'mandatory' Units 1 - 6 plus 2 other 'optional units'. 4 units are studied in Year 12 and 4 in Year 13.

Students studying Extended Certificate in Year 12 will study:

- **Unit 1 – Exploring Business** - This unit is assignment based, set and marked internally.
- **Unit 2 – Developing a Marketing Campaign** – Actual assessment in May - Over two days a controlled assessment unit where the task is set and marked externally.

Students studying the Foundation Diploma in Year 12 will also study:

- **Unit 19 – Pitching for a New Business**, an assignment based unit, set and marked internally

Students studying the Diploma in Year 12 will also study:

- **Unit 6 – Principle of Management** – Actual assessment in May - A controlled assessment unit where the task is set and marked externally.

Students studying Extended Certificate in Year 13 will study:

- **Unit 3 – Personal and Business Finance**, an externally assessed exam.
- **Unit 27 – Work experience in Business**, an assignment-based unit, set and marked internally. Students will be expected to organise 5 day's work experience during the summer holiday between Year 12 and Year 13. Students should seek opportunities outside of any normal part time work.

Students studying the Foundation Diploma in Year 13 will also study:

- **Unit 4 – Managing an Event** – This unit is assignment based, set and marked internally.

Students studying the Diploma in Year 13 will also study:

- **Unit 5 – International Business**, an assignment-based unit, set and marked internally

Each unit is assessed at Pass, Merit or Distinction level. A student's unit grades are then aggregated to give an overall qualification grade.
