


## **Seneca**

## **EdClass**

This Academic Year the College has signed up to an online learning education provider called **EdClass**. It has been accredited by the Department for Education.

This allows every student and teacher in the College access to 11,000 lessons online. This may be useful for revision or to supplement classroom or personalised learning. Every student can access the platform by following these steps:

### **Logging in**

**Your school ID:** amvc

The format for login credentials is as follows:

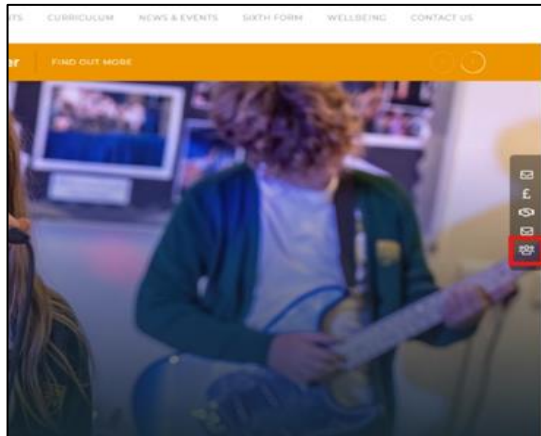
**Username:** First name and last name, all one word, Title case (eg JoeBloggs)

**Password:** The passwords are set as their date of birth in an 8-digit format. For example, the 22 July 1997 would be: 22071997

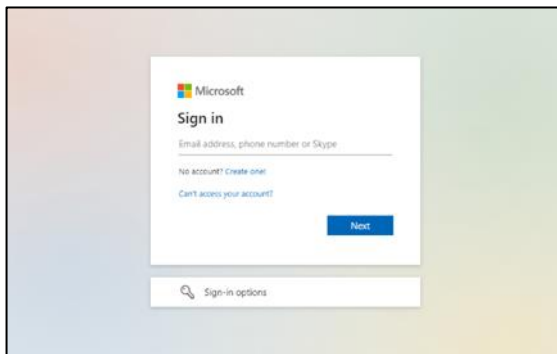
## Microsoft Teams

Click the **SharePoint** icon located on the right-hand menu bar.

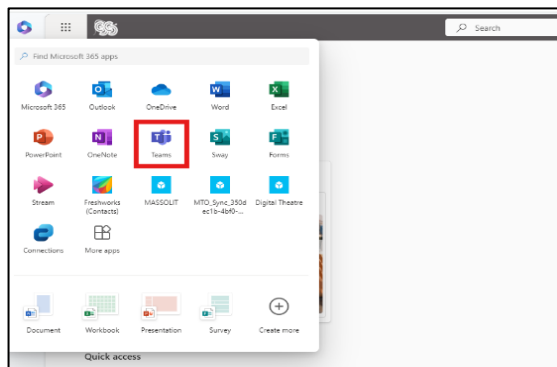

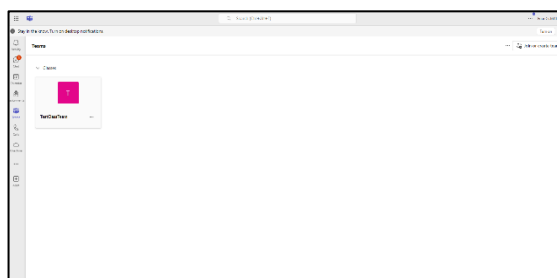
Enter your school email address and password.

You will now be able to see all of the Teams that you are a member of.

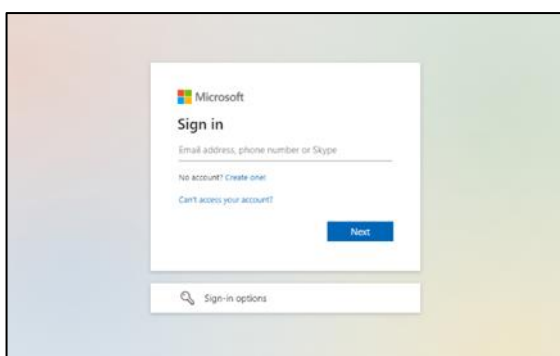
## Accessing your school emails from home

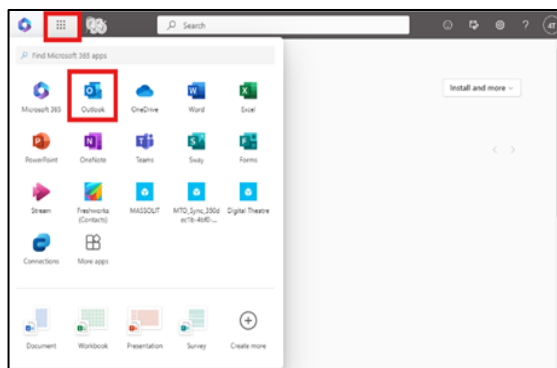

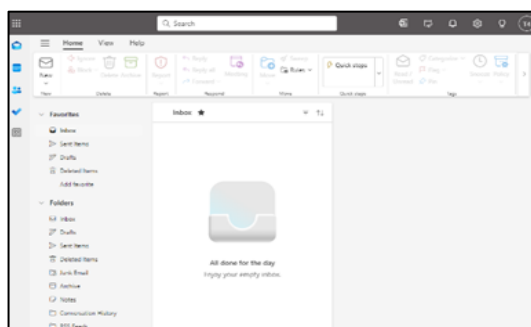
Enter your school email address and password.
