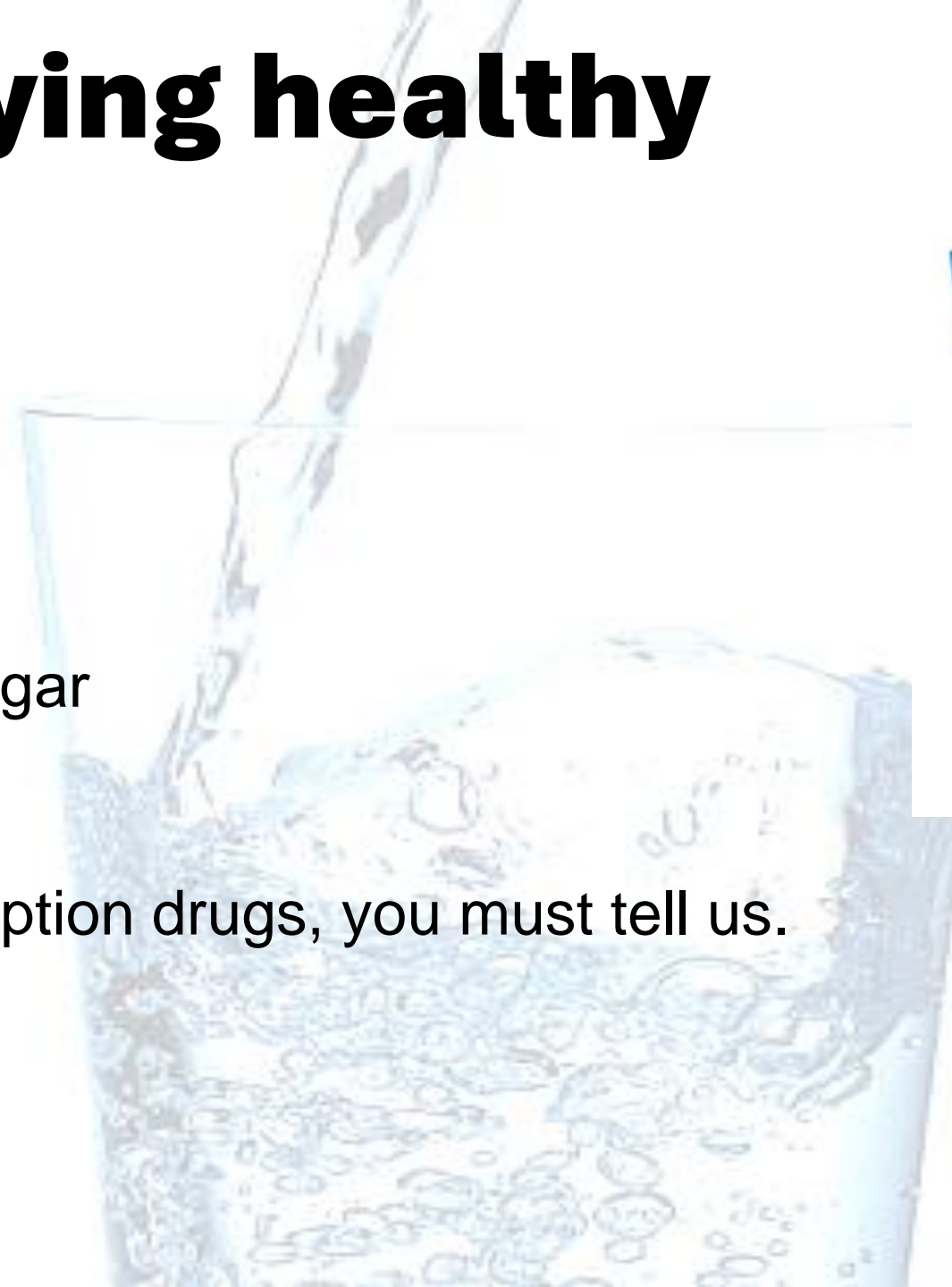
Volcanic Eruption

Emergency

- *“Although there’s no recent history of terrorism in Iceland, attacks cannot be ruled out.”*
 - Do not wait for your teacher
 - Leave your belongings
 - Do what emergency services tell you – they may be very direct
 - Run, Tell, Hide
- Mobile phones may not work immediately
- Please be patient and do not phone the emergency contact.

Packing

- Checked luggage up to 20 kg – remember to leave space for souvenirs, and check the booklet for dimensions
- If you padlock your case only use a combination lock.
- Bring a refillable bottle of water in your main luggage (you can drink tap water)
- Waterproofs and warm clothing
- Sensible shoes
- Small cabin/day bag
- Pen and pencil



Coach travel

- Wear your seat belt
- Sit properly on your seat
- Remain seated whilst the coach is moving
- If you listen to music, it will need to be through ear/headphones
- Keep the area around you tidy
- Please be patient and remain seated when we arrive places – you will need to listen to instructions



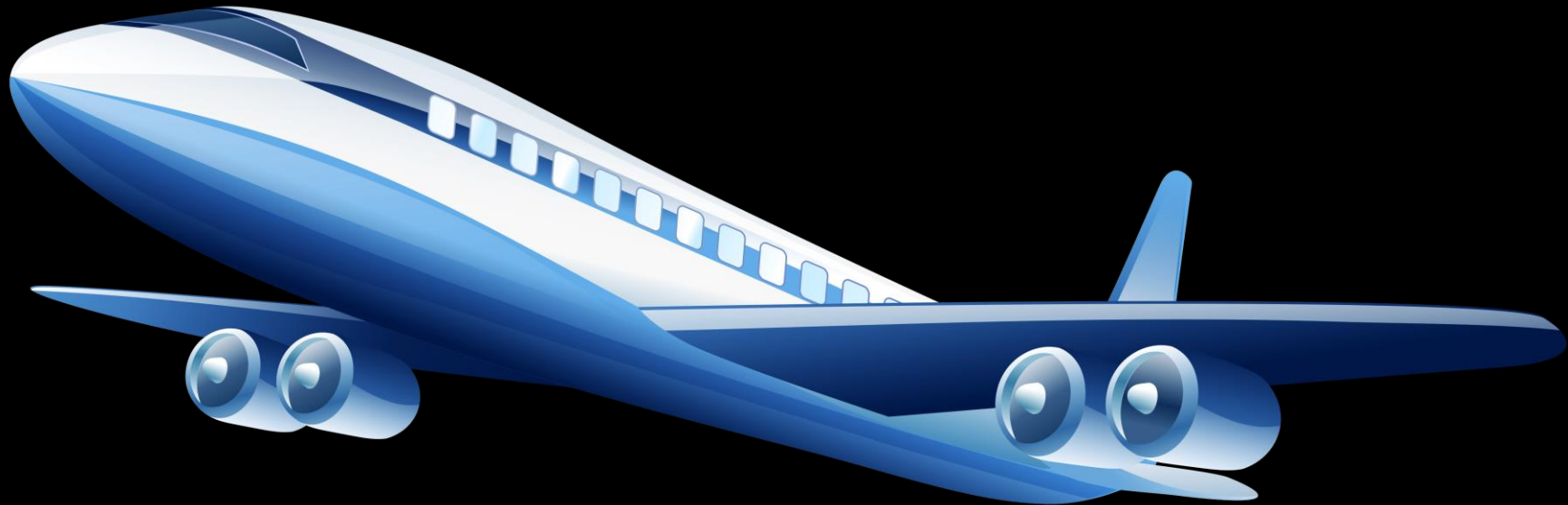
Airport
