



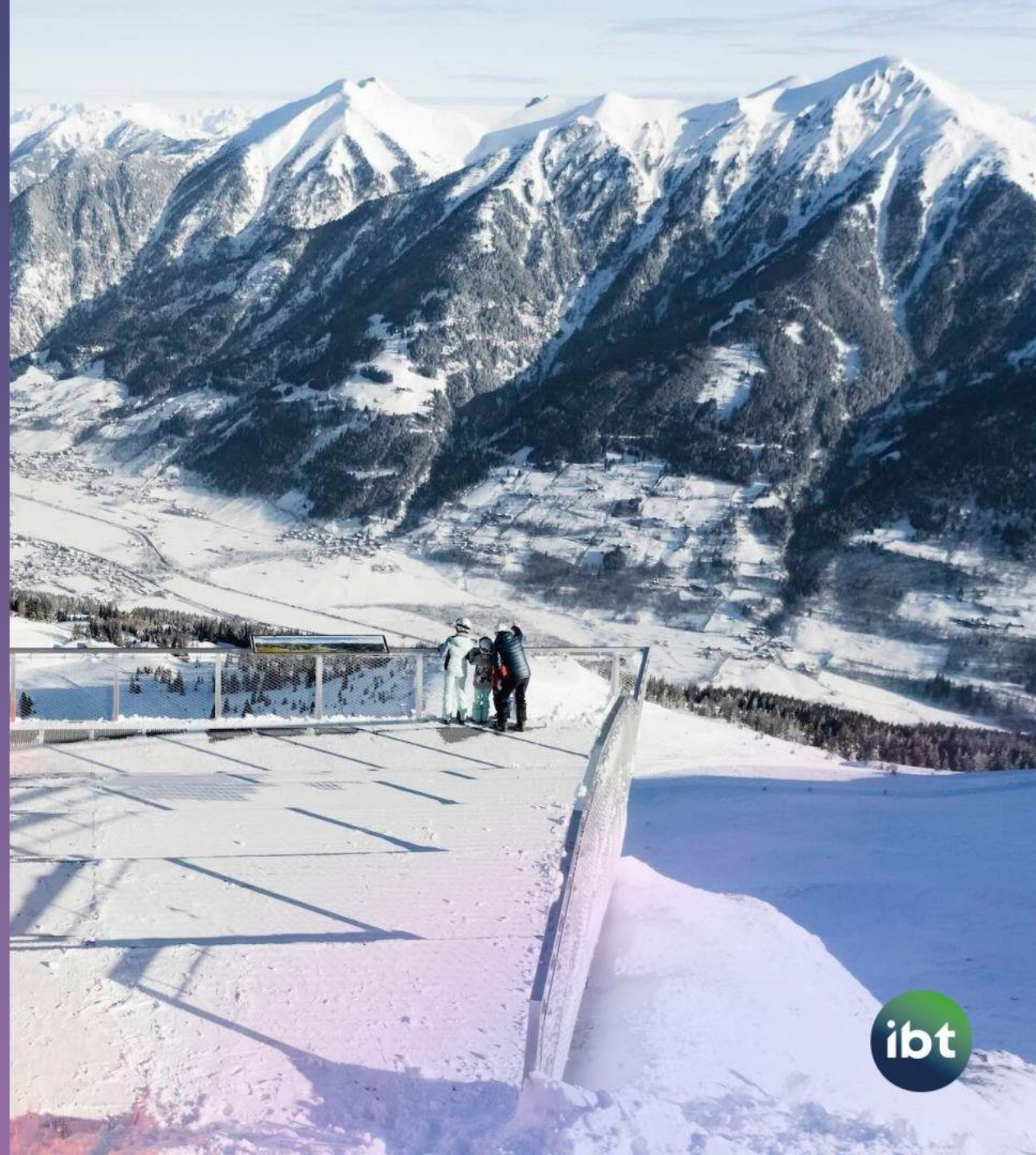

# What to take

- **Equipment** For personal equipment, please check with party leader for carriage charges and insurance
- **Jacket/Trousers** Outer garments should be waterproof and we suggest that salopettes be worn
- **Gloves** Waterproof with some form of lining
- **Hats** A good fitting hat (covering the ears)
- **Socks** Two or three pairs, long enough to be pulled up above the top of the boot
- **Under Jacket** Generally two or three thin layers will be better than one thick chunky garment
- **Glasses/Goggles** It is recommended to have both sunglasses and goggles
- **Lotion/Lip balm** It cannot be over-stressed that cream and balm be applied rigorously during the day

All journeys are operated by DoT-approved coach companies.

Students will travel in comfort and safety with our touring coaches, equipped with seat belts and air conditioning.

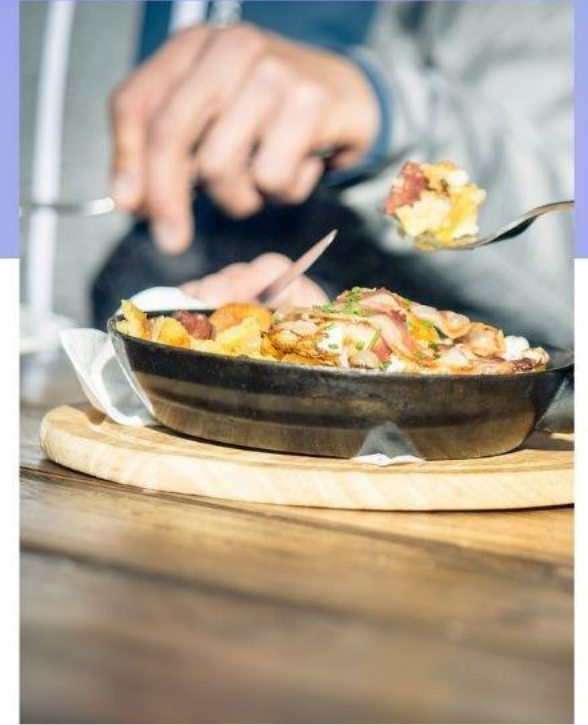
